



Motuora Island ?

Motuora is an open sanctuary owned by the people of New Zealand, administered by the Department of Conservation and managed in partnership by MRS and DOC.

What are we doing?

We are restoring Motuora to native forest habitat by planting native trees grown from seed collected on the island. This will enable us to release endangered species there. The focus is the creation of habitat for native birds lizards and invertebrates.

Why is Motuora important?

Motuora is, and always has been, predator free, which makes it ideal for forest restoration and for the creation of a habitat for endangered species.

This is an invitation to join us in this exciting conservation project!

Motuora is a unique island with sandy beaches and clear water. The island is a recreation reserve. Camping is permitted but there is no regular ferry service.

We offer you opportunities to visit this special place and to contribute to the work of establishing native forest there. Join us on working trips to the island for tree planting and nursery work, and learn about conservation in action. These trips are usually held on the last Sunday of each month.

You can also support this valuable restoration work by becoming a member of the Society or by sending a donation. Regular newsletters will keep you up to date with activities.
